Subject: "Fast" boat traffic on Eagle Spring Lake

The Eagle Spring Lake Management District representative and DNR have had on going discussions about whether the 'ski channel" (see map) should be used as part of the fast boat traffic route for skiing and tubing.

Your response to the following questions would be appreciated.

If the ski channel was designated Slow-No Wake could the main body of water safely accommodate our normal and peak boating activity?

If the "in only" channel were to have directional buoys would it be safe to route fast boat traffic around Penny Island and back out the same channel (see map)?

From my perspective, most of the time, (weekdays) there are zero to three fast boats (including jet skis) using the waters of Eagle Spring Lake. Can you give us an estimate of how many fast boats, including jet skis, use our lake during normal and peak periods (weekends and holidays)?

Any other thoughts you have would be appreciated.

If possible your response would be appreciated prior to October 10, 2005.
