

Town of Eagle Lake Patrol Monthly Report  
May 7, 2006 – June 11, 2006

To: Supervisor Don Malek

**Launching:** Boat officially put in and made ready for 2006 season on April 30, 2006. All equipment checked. One gas tank was removed because of problems with it.

**1<sup>st</sup> Day of Patrol:** May 7, 2006, report of a lot of small boats, canoes, and kayaks, otherwise slow. 34.5 hours of patrol time this period. Again, main focus is Saturdays, Sundays, and Holidays with staggering hours.

**Complaints:**

1. Lake resident reported he yelled at a speeding boat coming into ski channel wrong way. He tried to advise and warn him but he continued through channel exiting the in channel.
2. Lake resident wants us to monitor and take action for boaters coming too close to his pier on the point by South Shore Drive. He described 1 ski boat which we stopped and warned all the young people on it. Next time will be a ticket.
3. Two people in a canoe stopped me to report boats speeding in our channel to Lulu Lake and of a boat with 3 kids shooting fireworks off and speeding on Lulu Lake. Lulu Lake Patrol advised.
4. Lake residence stopped DNR warden who relayed to us of boats getting too close to his pier in Jack's Bay, before the S.N.W. buoy. We've patrolled there each time out and no one approached us on this complaint.

**Memorial Day Weekend:** Due to warm holiday weekend, we were very busy with more than usual boats on lake. We saw more canoes and kayaks and again more new people using this lake. On Monday, I advised and warned may small boats of a coming storm with hail and high winds that was reported on the weather band. There were a lot of people coming back from Lulu Lake at this time.
