

**Town of Eagle Lake Patrol Monthly Report
August 13, 2007 – September 16, 2007**

To: Supervisor Don Malek:

Patrol Hours for this Period: 53.5 Hours

We went out on Saturday, Sunday, Labor Day, and two mid-week evenings. One mid-week evening netted four underage drinkers. Three days were rained out.

Complaints:

- Request to check Tuesday evenings for numerous violations, mostly lake residents violating water ski regulations.
- Parking complaint behind Eagles Springs Pub blocking someone's driveway – advised to call Waukesha County Sheriff.
- Any evening, pontoon boats with no lights on.
- Yellow ski boat skiing too close to raft and going wrong direction on lake.

Special Notes:

- Removed a large tree from lake found floating near east shore.
- Assisted boater and advised, brakes went out on his truck as he launched his boat.
- Labor Day was active – found six young children on lake in little rubber boats with no PFD's. Their father was cited!
- Complaint last month of boater yelling profanities. I contacted boat owner and advised him of complaint and to let him know he will be held responsible for any issue involving his boat. He promised this will never happen again.
