- * July 1, 2009 I met with Eagle Fire Chief and showed him the boat and we went over a few things, he has a key now.
- * July 4, 2009 Fireworks went off well, no problems, counted about 70 boats.

- * July 4, 2009 Loud boat with cut out switch. Cited.
- * July 11, 2009 Accident between a PWC and a boat pulling 2 people.

We continue to monitor the boat launch and car count on highway when we get to the lake. It is filled a lot of the time with 4 to 9 trailers on Highway E.
