- * Towed in 2 boats that were disabled, one to DNR launch and one to lake owners pier.
- * 07-12-09 cited a youth for no Boat Safety Certificate but later found DNR had his name misspelled. I had his father fax me the information and I had the citation dismissed.
- * Advised new boat on lake of speed limit. The boat was a 21' ski boat with twin 160 hp inboard motors.

- * 07-26-09 assisted Lulu Lake Patrol escorting a boat off the lake.
