# TOWN OF EAGLE LAKE PATROL MONTHLY REPORT

May 19, 2010

On April 6, 2010, I attended the 2010 DNR statewide Water Patrol Training held at the Stoney Creek Conference Center, Rothschild, WI. I was the patrol representative for both the Town of Eagle and the Town of Mukwonago. Attendance is mandatory in order for the patrols to qualify for State Reimbursement Aids. State reimbursement to patrols in 2009 was approximately 71% of net costs. State Aid has always had a cap of 75%, but for 2010 there will be no cap. The 2009 Water Patrol State Reimbursement check to the Town of Eagle was \$11,966.13. This does not include any fines or forfeitures received by the Town from Municipal Court proceedings.

On Saturday, May 1, 2010, I, along with the much appreciated help of Tom Day, launched the Town boat. I patrolled minimum day shifts hours for the first 2 weekends in May as weather kept boat traffic down. I did write 2 citations and issued several written warnings, as is now required by a U.S. Coast Guard Survey request on warnings.

The Town boat is in good operating order. The Town's 2-way boat radio is in A-1 condition thanks to a local lake resident's (who requested to remain anonymous) donation and installation of a new Motorola 2-way radio for the Town boat. Some areas of the lake had dead spots which affected radio traffic. Now we have excellent reception and transmission at no cost to the Town, thanks to a concerned citizen.

The Town of Mukwonago Police Department is offering a 2 day DNR Boating Safety Course on Friday, June 11, and Saturday, June 12, 2010. It is being held at the Mukwonago Fire Department. Anyone interested in attending should call 262 363-5188.
